29. Transportation Demand Management (TDM) (2 pages)

Introduces the concept of adopting a variety of public/private programs for reducing traffic congestion such as adjusted work hours to reduce rush hour traffic, commuter matching services, and requiring bicycle racks, lockers and showers as part of business development projects.
